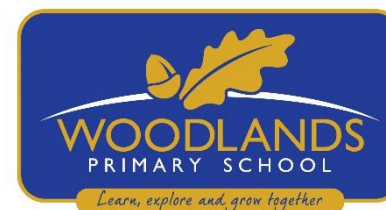

Terms 3 and 4 Curriculum Outline 2018/19

English	Term 3 – The Owl who was Afraid Of the Dark. We will have the opportunity to sequence the story and write a recount, write book reviews, produce non-fiction writing about nocturnal animals, write poems, write a letter to Plop and write character profiles. We will take part in drama and role-play based around the book. Term 4 – The Great Fire of London. We will write diaries, newspaper reports and stories about the Great Fire of London. We will learn about fire safety and write instructions and commands to keep ourselves and others safe. We will take part in drama based around the Great Fire of London.	
Maths	Throughout both terms we will be consolidating and extending our skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be applying these skills to problem solving activities. We will practise telling the time and measuring mass, temperature and capacity. We will be finding fractions of shapes and numbers. We will look at data handling and we will answer questions about totalling and comparing data. We will also be learning about position, direction and movement, including rotation and anti-clockwise and clockwise.	
Science In Term 3, we will be studying living things and their habitats. The children will describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of animals and plants, and how these depend on each other. In Term 4, we will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials (including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard) for particular uses. We will be finding out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.	Geography We will be naming and locating the characteristics of the four countries and capitals of the UK and its surrounding seas. We will be looking at aerial photos and we will be making maps. History We will be learning about The Great Fire of London: the key dates and the order of events that took place at the time. We will research important people from that period (Samuel Pepys, King Charles II and the baker of Pudding Lane) and we will write a newspaper article.	Art We will be learning the skills needed for sketching and drawing silhouettes. The children will be studying the work of L.S.Lowry. DT We will be designing and making bread.

<p>Computing</p> <p>We will be reminding ourselves about the importance of E-Safety. We will also be learning how to use the internet safely to search for information and pictures. We will be practising our typing and learning how to use a word processing program to type up our facts and print them out.</p> <p>We will be creating and debugging simple programs. We will be using logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of our programs.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>We will be learning about rhythm and beat in music. We will also be exploring our voice and musical symbols.</p> <p>We will use these skills to further our understanding of musical notations when we return to learning the ocarina in Term 4.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>We will continue our learning of gymnastic skills over both terms.</p> <p>During Term 3 we will also practise the skills needed for games and we will use these to play games.</p> <p>During Term 4 we will be exploring the theme of the Great Fire of London through the media of dance and drama.</p>
