



YR Trip to Chatham Historic Dockyard – 08/02/19

Trip Description	As part of our topic on Pirates, Reception pupils will be visiting Chatham Historic Dockyard for the day.
Departure Time	We will be leaving school at 9.00am. Your child must be in school at 8.45am for registration.
Returning Time	We will return to school at approximately 3.15pm.
What to Wear	Your child will need to wear a school sweatshirt, comfy trousers and sensible footwear (trainers would be ideal) and bring a warm waterproof coat.
Food & Drink	Your child will need a healthy packed lunch in a small rucksack (no chocolate or sweets) and drinks in disposable plastic bottles (no cans, fizzy drinks or glass bottles). If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium and you require a packed lunch for the day, please contact the kitchen directly by ringing 01732 355577 and choose option 2. This needs to be arranged at least one week before the trip.
What they need	A small rucksack because the children need to carry their own packed lunch.
Medicine/Sickness	If your child requires medication on the trip and/or suffers from travel sickness please speak to your child's class teacher.
Cost	The cost of the trip is £11.85 which covers the cost of the coach and entrance to the Dockyard. Under the terms of the Education Reform Act, this is a voluntary contribution, but if the costs are not met, the trip may have to be cancelled. <u>Payments should be made via Parent Mail</u> from Wednesday 19 th December, using the trips link. If you have any problems with this, please contact the school office.
Permission Slip	The label in your child's reading record/homework diary will need to be signed to give permission for this trip.
