



### Swimming Data 2020

The National Curriculum states pupils should be taught to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

Meeting national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety	
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres?	86% (pupil questionnaire)
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?	83% (pupil questionnaire)
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	65% (pupil questionnaire)
