

Spellings!

In addition to using the Look, Cover and Write sheet, you may also wish to use some of the strategies below to learn your spellings.

1. Rainbow Words- Write your words and trace over them in 3 different colours.
2. Ransom Words- Cut letters out of newspaper, magazines, or write them out on paper and cut them, then glue them together to build your words.
3. Hidden Words- Write your words and find hidden words in your words.
E.g. that – hat – at
4. Shaving cream/sand Words- Write your words out in shaving cream or sand.
5. Tracing Words- Trace your words in sand, on felt or in the carpet using your finger.
6. Word Search- Create a word search on www.puzzlemaker.com and then find your words.
7. Word Hunt- Search for your words in books/texts or around the house.
Write your words as you find them.
8. Font-abulous- Type your words in 3 different fonts on the computer or if you're feeling really arty, could you design your own fonts?
9. Chalk Talk- Write your words in chalk on a chalk board or if you don't have one of these you can do this activity with a white board and marker.
10. 3 Way Words- Write your words three ways - really big, really small, and in your best handwriting. What about doing it in different colours?
12. Trace & Spell- Have someone write your words neatly. Trace the words spelling out each letter in the word.
