



Our theme for Term 6 is The Enchanted Woods.

This is our What we are Learning for week beginning 14th June 2021.

- **Literacy** – We will be looking at the traditional tale of Goldilocks. We will be writing a simple sorry letter to the 3 bears from Goldilocks and the children will have lots of opportunities to explore activities related to the story.
- **Communication and Language** – A member of staff dressed as a police officer will be talking to the children about what Goldilocks has been doing. What did Goldilocks do? Did she make the right choice? How could she make it up to the 3 bears?
- **Phonics** – All classes will be reinforcing sounds, segmenting and blending words in addition to practising their writing.
- **Maths** – This week we will be recapping capacity and introducing weight. The children will be able to explore both of these concepts in relation to Goldilocks as well as real world situations. Which bowl is the heaviest? How do you know? Which bowl holds the most? Which one is the fullest? We will be using vocabulary such as empty, full, emptiest, heavy and lightest.
- **Expressive Arts and Design** – We will be creating our own salt dough or clay woodland creatures. We will be using natural resources such as sticks and leaves to add details.
- **Understanding the World** – We will be following the children's interests and looking at facts all about hedgehogs. Where do they live? What do they eat? Why are hedgehogs so special in a garden?
- **PSED** – This week we will be looking at stranger danger and gently talking about keeping safe around unfamiliar people. We will be looking at how to look for a 'kind stranger' in different situations such as if we get lost.
