



## **Our theme for Term 6 is The Enchanted Woods.**

### **This is our What we are Learning for week beginning 28th June 2021.**

- **Literacy** – We will be looking at the story of 'What the ladybird heard' by Julia Donaldson. We will be looking at directional language and writing our own set of instructions to get from one place to another using a map from the story.
- **Phonics** – Due to guidance we are no longer setting phonics groups, instead we will be teaching in classes. We will be focusing on set 2 sounds and writing sentences. The children are encouraged to apply their phonic knowledge independently in their writing.
- **Maths** – This week we will be looking at the value of numbers 16,17,18 & 19. We will recap how teen numbers and are made up of a ten and some ones. We will be ordering, comparing and making them with different resources.
- **Expressive Arts and Design** – This week the children will be creating their own ladybird. They will choose how to create their ladybird and will be encouraged to get as creative as possible!
- **Understanding the World** – We will be looking at facts about ladybirds. What food do ladybirds eat? Why are some ladybirds different colours? What is special about them?
- **PSED** – This week we will be talking about how we feel as we prepare to move to Year One.
