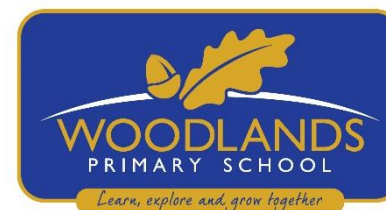


Year 2

Terms 3 and 4 Curriculum Outline

<p>English</p>	<p>Term 3 – The Owl who was Afraid Of the Dark – an overcoming fear tale. We will have the opportunity to sequence the story and write a recount. Our focus will continue to be to use the correct punctuation and to make our sentences more exciting by using adjectives. We will write a letter to Plop and develop ideas for character profiles. The children take part in drama and role-play based around the book. We will also produce non-fiction accounts of The Great Fire of London.</p> <p>Term 4 – Fantastic Mr Fox – an overcoming a monster tale. This term the focus will be on producing non-fiction writing about nocturnal animals and we will create a fact file. The children will also be writing riddles in our poetry sessions.</p>	
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Throughout both terms we will be consolidating place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will continue to count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. and learn these times tables. In shape we will thinking about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, sorting shapes, lines of symmetry and making patterns with shape. We will practise telling the time and understanding position and direction including rotation and anti-clockwise and clockwise. We will also be learning about finding fractions of shapes and numbers,</p>	
<p>Science</p> <p>Term 3 – Animals, including Humans. We will be discovering more about animal offspring and their parents and comparing this to the babies and how growth of humans. We will be thinking about basic needs for all living creatures (feeding, drinking and breathing) and the importance of food, hygiene and exercise in a healthy lifestyle.</p> <p>Term 4 - Plants. In this topic children will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>The title of our History topic will be “The Great Fire of London.” We will be learning about the key dates and the order of events that took place at the time. We will be researching important people – Samuel Pepys, King Charles II and Thomas Farriner and writing a newspaper article.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>Term 3 – Camouflage. The children will be looking at paintings by Henry Rousseau. They will be learning the skills to create a wash for the backgrounds to their picture and then try to recreate the painting “Surprise! A Tiger in a Tropical Storm.”</p> <p>DT</p> <p>Term 4 – Making Bread. We will be designing and making bread.</p>

<p>Computing</p> <p>Term 3 – Coding. This term the children will use coding tiles to program the Blue Bot and explore the different algorithms that they can make. The children will become more familiar with debugging programmes and increase their awareness of how coding works.</p> <p>Term 4 – Using a program to produce a document. We will use a computer software program to recreate art. The children will learn to change colours, fill blocks, draw lines, rotate, resize and colour shapes and produce lighter and darker shades of a colour.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>In Terms 3 and 4 children will continue to learn the ocarina, focusing on rhythm and pitch, we will then be exploring pitch further with boomwhackers.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>We will continue our learning of gymnastic skills over both terms.</p> <p>Term 3 - We will also practise the skills needed for games and we will use these to play games.</p> <p>Term 4 - We will be exploring the theme of the Great Fire of London through the media of dance and drama.</p>
<p>RE</p> <p>Term 3 – We will explore the question “How and why do we celebrate sacred times?”</p> <p>Term 4 – We will explore the question “What does it mean to belong to a faith community?”</p>		<p>PSHE</p> <p>Term 1 – Dreams and Goals. We will be learning how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this. We will discuss having a positive attitude and to keep trying even when it is difficult!</p> <p>Term 2 – Healthy Me. We will learn about being and keeping safe and healthy. The children will focus on making healthy choices, being physically active and how to be a good friend.</p>
