Supplies

- At least 3 large cardboard boxes.
 The more boxes you have,
 the longer your tunnel will be.
 - · Duct tape
- Craft Knife and/or scissors (Ask an adult for help with the cutting!)
 - · Paint, markers, stickers, etc.

Build a Boxitect Tunnel:

 Open up both ends of each box.




Line up boxes in a row with flaps slightly overlapping.



Tape the boxes together with duct tape.



4. Cut out any windows and doors you want.







Boxitect Challenge: Make your tunnel unique! Try a door made of streamers, using a string of lights, or even adding a cardboard periscope! If you have a lot of boxes, try making a tunnel maze!
