Results 2025



- At A level an Average grade of C across A level subjects with more than 40% of grades at A/A* and 71% of grades awarded at A* to C
- All students securing the courses / careers of their choices including university places

- More than 230 grades at 6s, 7s, 8s and 9s across all subject areas




Leigh Academies Trust

International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (MYP)

- We are an IB MYP candidate school, delivering the 3 year MYP programme at Key Stage 3 (Year 7, 8 and 9).
- The MYP is an internationally recognised programme that goes beyond the national curriculum and prepares students to be global citizens.
- The programme is delivered via EIGHT subject disciplines that focus on developing a holistic learner via the IB learner profile.
